PARKING

Parking on the Street

- Parking is prohibited when it is snowing, there is a forecast of snow or when plows and sanders are in use. If need be, the car you park on the street can be parked in our parking lot until your street is cleared. A fine of \$25.00 will be imposed for the first offense; each additional violation will be \$50.00.

- Vehicles must face in the direction of traffic. Cars must be parked no less than 10 feet from street intersections. Corner property, at the discretion of the Board of Directors, may be allowed a double driveway on a case-by-case basis if safety concerns are an issue.

- Recreational vehicles (boats, trailers, campers, etc.) may be kept in the driveway or on the street in front of the stockholder's residence for no more than three (3) days when loading, unloading or servicing. Exceptions will be considered upon submission of a written request to the Board.

WATER CONSERVATION

The Department of Environmental Protection, Division of Water Resources controls the use of water in the State of New Jersey.

1. For the months of June, July, August and September, watering will be limited to a five hour period between the hours of 7:00 A.M. to 12:00 NOON **OR** 5:00 P.M. to 8:00 P.M. Starting on June 1, 2022.

2. *The Odd-Even system will apply.* That is: those houses with odd numbers will water on the odd calendar date; those houses with even numbers will water on the even calendar date. WHERE THERE ARE THIRTY-ONE (31) DAYS IN THE MONTH, NO WATERING WILL BE PERMITTED ON THE 31ST BY ANYONE.

For those individuals who violate this regulation, the matter will be referred to our Corporate Attorney for legal action.

We must try to conserve on water. Please cooperate and water only during your regulated period.

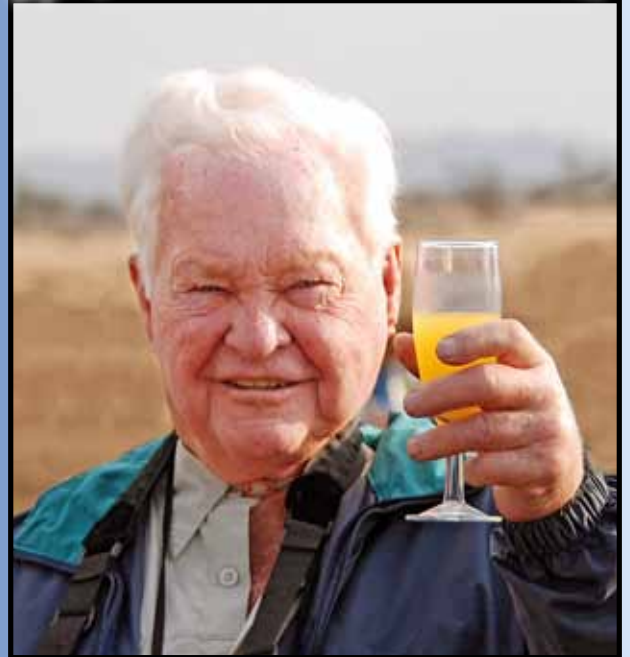

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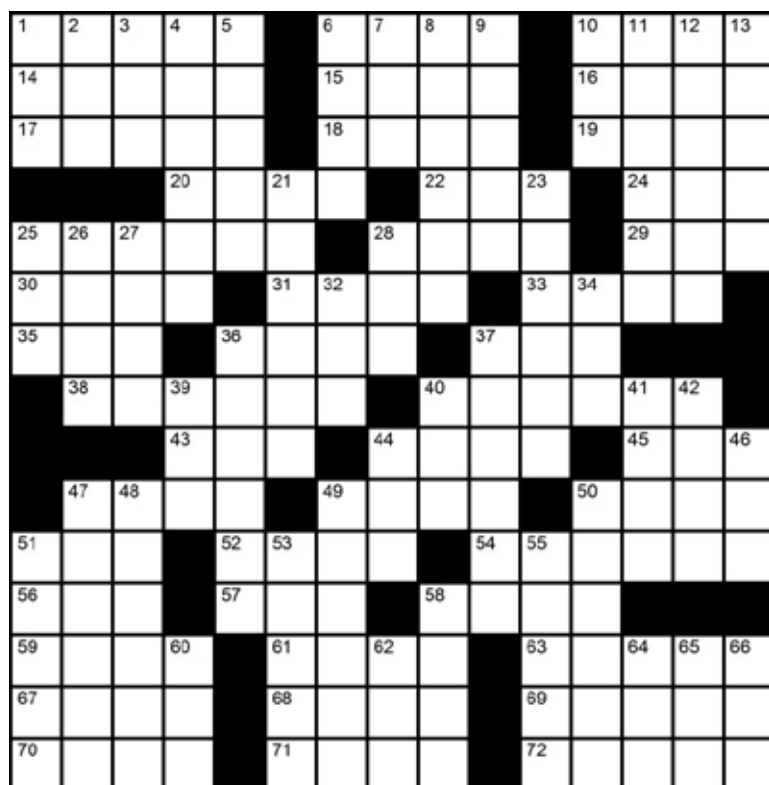
