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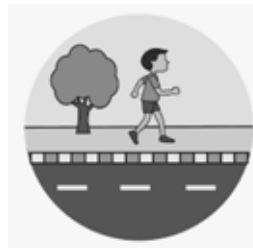

- Items may be placed out 48 hours prior
- Furniture, appliances, carpeting, bedding, metal

NOT ALLOWED:

- Piles larger than 4' x 4'
- Dark plastic bags
- Hazardous items and construction debris

Please be sure not to park vehicles in front of piles. Please keep piles small and neat.

If a pile is marked as "unacceptable" by the township, it is the homeowners responsibility to remove the waste. The township will not come back. These items can be brought to Jackson Twp. Convenience Center on Don Connor Blvd – Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Friday and Saturday, 8:00am to 3:45pm.

Pool: The calendar for the pool is included in this issue. We want to send out a huge **THANK YOU** to everyone who's been cooperating with the pool passes again this year. This is our second year with a pool monitor, and although not everyone is using the sign-in sheets on resident-only days, a good portion of you are—so, thank you!

Bus Trips: We have weekly bus trips to the food stores, every Thursday, unless there is a holiday! Please refer to the bus calendar in this issue and sign up by 4pm on the day prior.

Street Lights Out If you notice a street light out in the community, please report it to the management office with the pole number, street name, and nearest cross street where the outage is located. This information helps us properly report the issue to JCP&L. Without the correct information, we are unable to submit the outage request to the company.

Missed Recycling: Please remember your recycling pick up is offered by the township, through your taxes not your HOA fees. If your recycling is missed, the office is happy to call on your behalf but note that you also can call 609-771-8005 as this is a private service not an HOA service.

Architectural Applications: All exterior work requires an application. While the volunteer committee has up to 21 days to review, it usually takes much less time. **Be sure to submit a complete form with a picture or sample to avoid delays—**
incomplete applications will be returned. The community looks great—let's keep it that way by following the rules. Also, any digging in your yard requires you to call Federal Irrigation and the 1-800 number listed at the bottom of the architectural application. Skipping this step can result in damage to irrigation, gas, or power lines—and any repairs will be the homeowner's responsibility.

Landscaping: Landscape work is at full swing. If you have any questions with regard to landscaping, be sure to reach out the office. All work orders and questions need to come through us. Please note that the **landscapers cannot weed whack against any house that has siding that goes all the way to the ground, unless there is a garden bed along the house.** This is to avoid unavoidable damage to your siding.

Irrigation: The sprinklers are up and running. Remember that if you see any issues, please report them to the office. Do not attempt to repair anything yourself! We will put in work tickets for any issues, including, but not limited to: directional issues, water pressure and broken sprinkler heads. If you choose to do work that requires the relocation of a sprinkler head, or just desire it, it would be the responsibility of the homeowner to contact Federal Irrigation, schedule it and pay for it.

Architectural Committee

Please remember an Architectural Application is needed **with an approval** from the Architectural Committee before any work can start. You must allow up to 21 days for approval, so plan accordingly. Applications are needed for, but not limited to:

- All shrub and tree removal/planting
- Painting house, doors, shutters, etc.
- Landscape work: Seeding, Edging, Creating/expanding beds, etc.
- Any modification to the exterior of your home & property. You can refer to Title III, Rule 2.5 of the Winding Ways Rules & Regulations for the exceptions.

Be sure to hire only licensed and insured contractors for your protection and the protection of the HOA! It's a requirement of the HOA!

Also remember, when your work is complete, call the Management Office for a final inspection, which is required before your Bond can be released.

NOTE:

The following work will require a work bond to be held in the office:

Patio replacement/extensions, driveway work, garage door replacement, roof replacement, garden window replacement, solar panels, and retractable awnings. This list is subject to change to include any permanent structural changes.

Any questions, please call the Architectural Committee or the Management Office for direction. Applications are available in the clubhouse lobby bins.

The Association requires that homeowners submit applications for **all** exterior modifications & most plantings. **ONE APPLICATION FOR EACH JOB REQUIRED!**

Homeowners must receive approval from the Architectural Review Committee prior to work commencing. For landscaping applications, mark-outs are required prior to approval. **HOMEOWNER SIGNATURE REQUIRED ON FRONT AND BACK!**

Without proper back up your application may be rejected. **Approvals will put in your tube after your application is reviewed.** You must include the contractor's name, address, license number, and proof of liability and worker's compensation insurance with your application. **If you choose to do the work yourself, then you must sign here stating that you assume all liability for any injuries and/or damages to your home, adjoining properties, and/or common property:**

You must allow at least 3 weeks for your approval. If you do not receive your notice of approval within 21 days, please call the Management Office at 732-928-0300.

NOTICE

For all tree removal, Jackson Township requires a permit at the cost of \$35.00. If a permit is not obtained you may be subject to a \$2,000 fine per occurrence from the township. Permit applications are available in the Management Office.

NJ State law states that "Digging of any kind, such as for; mailboxes, flagpoles, trees and large shrubs, requires a call to 1-800-272-1000 for a **FREE** mark out of the area involved" The person doing the digging must make the call! It is important to note that Title III, Chapter 2-4 Paragraph states: Homeowners shall be responsible for any damage or injury that results to any building, person or property, arising out of the installation of the subject matter of the application. Also a mark out of sprinkler heads may be required. Please call Federal Irrigation to inquire and schedule at 732-349-9905.

Please note, the following applications require a Bond to be held: Concrete Work to include but not limited to: Patio Enclosures or Extensions, Patio Replacements, Sidewalk and Walkways repairs and replacements. Retractable Patio Awnings, Garage Door Replacement, Solar Tubes, Window and Door Replacement, Roof Replacement, Solar Roof Panel. Inquire with Management for amount of Bond. Check must be signed and turned in with application. Checks are not cashed, but held as bond.

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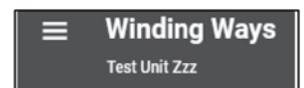

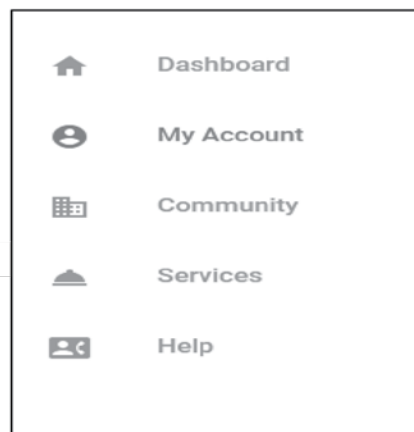

Summer Food Safety Tips

Summertime brings backyard barbecues, beach picnics, & outdoor potlucks. However, the CDC warns that the number of people who contract foodborne illnesses spike drastically during the summer months.

To protect your guests and keep your summer celebrations safe follow the core pillars of food safety: **clean, separate, cook and chill.**

1 CLEAN



- **Wash hands:** Use soap and warm water for 20 seconds.
- **Bring backups:** Pack wet wipes and sanitizer if water is unavailable.
- **Scrub grills:** Clean grates with a nylon brush or foil.
- **Prep produce:** Rinse fruits and vegetables at home before packing.

2 SEPARATE



- **Two coolers:** Use one for drinks and one for food.
- **Bag meat:** Wrap raw meat in plastic bags at store.
- **Layer cooler:** Place sealed raw meat at the very bottom.
- **Switch plates:** Never place cooked food on raw meat plates.

3 COOK



Use thermometers: Do not rely on meat color for safety.

- **Poultry:** 165°F (74°C)
- **Ground meat:** 160°F (71°C)
- **Whole cuts:** 145°F (63°C) (with 3-minute rest)
- **Seafood:** 145°F (63°C)

4 CHILL



- **Under 90°F:** Toss food left out past 2 hours.
- **Over 90°F:** Toss food left out past 1 hour.
- **Cooler temperature:** Keep ice-packed coolers below 40°F.
- **Ice baths:** Place serving bowls inside larger ice bowls.
- **Store fast:** Refrigerate leftovers within 2 hours in shallow containers.

OFFICIAL SWIMMING POOL REGULATIONS (TITLE 11-2-5)

2-5 Swimming Pool

2-5.01 **Hours/Dates of Operation:** The pool will open Memorial Day weekend and will close on Labor Day. The hours of operation will be set by the Board of Trustees. All dates and hours are to be published. **"Swim at Own Risk"** is a pool policy and the **Buddy system** must be utilized at all times. The buddy system requires an adult to be present poolside at all times.

2-5.02 **Access:** Access to the pool area is from the North & South Entrances & will require a fob. If in wet bathing attire, please either change in the locker room or dry off before walking through the clubhouse. Shoes and Shirts **MUST** be worn in the clubhouse. Entry to the clubhouse will require the use of a key fob at the locker room. To exit the pool area to the parking lot, use the north gate.

2-5.03 **Guests:** Guests are allowed to use the pool only in the presence of their sponsoring resident and only on specific days. Residents have priority over the use of chairs. Each household is allowed to bring a maximum of four (4) guests with badges to use the facilities at any one time. Children must be supervised by a responsible adult resident at all times.

2-5.04 **Minimum Age Requirement:** Only children who are three (3) years of age or older will be allowed to use the pool.

2-5.05 **Local & NJ State Health Regulations:** Local and NJ State Health Regulations shall be followed by users of the pool facilities at all times. All pool users must shower before using the pool in accordance with NJ State Health Requirements. **NO swimming when thunder is present.**

2-5.06 **Attire:** Proper swimming attire is required for use of the pool. Street clothes of any sort cannot be used as swim attire. Cover-ups, such as hats or T-shirts, are permitted for sunburn protection. Any person who is incontinent or not fully potty trained must wear appropriate waterproof clothing when entering or being assisted into the pool.

2-5.07 **Conduct:** In addition to the conduct specified in Title II, Section 2-3.03, running or horseplay is not allowed in the pool area.

2-5.08 **Pool Rule Enforcement:** Pool Monitors, when on duty, are authorized to enforce all rules and regulations regarding the use of swimming pool facilities. Where violations of such rules and regulations continue to occur, monitors shall notify their supervisor or the Community Manager or Trustee, who shall take appropriate action.

2-5.09 **Off-Hours Use:** Access to the pool area is allowed, but swimming is not allowed under any circumstance.

2-5.10 **Food/Drink:**

- a. Food is allowed on deck areas around the pool but not in the pool itself.
- b. Nonalcoholic drinks are allowed anywhere on the pool deck, but must be in unbreakable plastic or metal containers. Alcoholic beverages are **NOT** permitted in accordance with Title II 2-3.08. Glass containers are not permitted anywhere in the pool enclosure.
- c. Residents are responsible for making sure that the areas are kept clean and that food and drink do not get into the pool or landscape beds.

2-5.12 **Diving or Jumping:** Diving or jumping into the pool is **NOT** allowed for safety reasons.

2-5.13 **Flotation Devices:** Flotation devices such as kick boards, rafts, etc. are not allowed in the pool area. However, noodles are allowed. In the wading pool, children are allowed to use child size floating devices such as small rafts, only when accompanied in pool with adult. Training devices for children are acceptable (such as arm swimmies and back bubbles).

2-5.14 **Pool Furniture:** Pool furniture will be used on a first-come, first-served basis, and residents have priority on the use of pool furniture. Furniture may not be reserved by placing towels on chairs or by any other method of reserving.

- a. Residents should lower the umbrellas and return furniture to the original location when leaving the pool area or if inclement weather threatens. This is a safety request as the umbrellas can be blown over in high winds and cause property damage and or personal injury.

2-5.15 **Pool Partition:** For your own safety and the safety of other residents and guests, no one is allowed to walk on or across the partition between the main pool and the shallow pool in the pavilion area.

2-5.16 **Handicap Lift:** The handicap lift is for the use of handicapped individuals only.

2-5.18 **Smoking:** Smoking & Vaping is prohibited in the entire pool area as well as recreational common areas. Please use designated smoking areas (signs are posted).

2-5.19 **Baby Pools:** Plastic and inflatable kiddie pools are not permitted within the confines of the pool area.

2-5.20 **Headphones:** Headphones or ear buds must be used in the pool area. **No** open music is allowed.
